*The UE Ranger is an assistive motion device for patients recovering from physical impairments associated with the multitude of shoulder pathologies (pain, swelling and inflammation, neuro-muscular imbalances, muscle weakness, and limited range-of-motion). In terms of Truly Healing Motion there is a fine line of therapeutically influencing that which impairs versus accommodating perpetuating patho-mechanics, for example, substitutions and compensations. The UE Ranger affords the clinician the opportunity to safely and meaningfully intervene in the acute stage of recovery influencing the natural processes of tissue healing while setting the tone for both efficient and effective active assistive progressions as follows.*

## Passive Range of Motion (PROM)

Clinical difference between the UE Ranger and Pendulums or Forward Bows:

The UE Ranger mimics in a functionally meaningful manner the capacity to relax the typically hypertonic protection muscles, such as the Upper Trapezius, Levator Scapulae, Scalenes and Anterior Deltoid, while reorganizing a balanced gleno-humeral relation that:

- Proprioceptively supports pain free mobility
- Circulatory supports resolution of swelling, inflammation and resultant oxygenated blood to sites of tissue healing
- Neurologically provides subtle yet meaningful core influences of foundational motor control
- Offers multi-plane exploration and graded progressions of motion recovery
- Offers pre-manual relaxation warm up and post-manual integrative carry over

Pendulums and forward bows for a guarded person in pain, potentially fearful of bending over due to any form of balance disorder are next to impossible to provide a consistent therapeutic or functionally meaningful influence.

## Active Assistive Range of Motion (AAROM)

Clinical difference between tools requiring a gripped hand versus the open hand support of the UE Ranger:

- Gripped hand – produces co-contractions through the distal upper extremity interfering with re-establishing balanced tone and reorganizing sub acute coordinated movement patterns essential for functional strengthening
- Gripped hand - requires efficient coordinations and endurances of currently impaired proximal stabilizers, promoting recruitment of substitutions and perpetuation of patho-mechanics
- Gripped hand - is a component of the Startle Reflex, promoting apprehensions, guarded tone and resultant pain avoidance compensations

*Within these capacities to meet the healing requirements of each of your patient's individual impairment levels, **the UE Ranger therapeutically becomes an extension of your clinical knowledge and skills.***
